Golf was not only a sport she excelled at, but also a way she built friendships and enjoyed healthy competition! Dorothy never lost her enthusiasm for sports and friendly rivalry. She loved cheering on the Texas Rangers and the Dallas Cowboys. She also enjoyed playing bridge with friends, and sharing lively games of Uno and double solitaire with her grandchildren.

Her leadership and commitment to service were evident in the many organizations she supported. She served as president of the Waverly Club, the Women's Forum, and the Women's Golf Association at SSCC, which later honored her with a lifetime membership! She also contributed her time to the boards of the Cemetery Society and the Sulphur Springs Public Library. In addition, she was active in the PTA and the Red River Council of Girl Scouts and was a devoted member of the First United Methodist Church.

Dorothy's greatest pride was her family. Her legacy includes three grandchildren - Susan Sanders, Trent Salch and Holly Thompson - who adored her deeply and miss her tremendously. They hope to carry forward the values of determination, generosity, and the joyful spirit for life she exemplified every day!

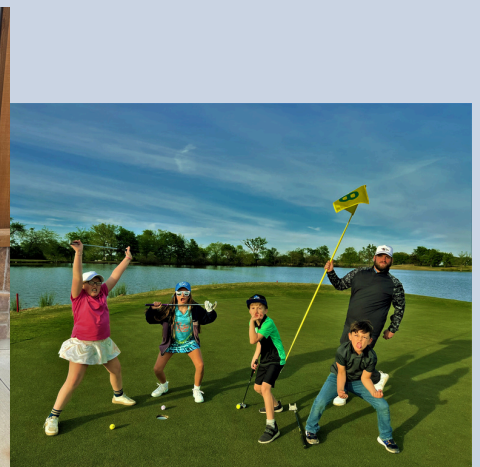

In honor of Father's Day, I wanted to share with you guys the dish I love to make for my father. He has supported me throughout my whole life and is the best corner man a son could ask for!

My dad is a simple man. He likes what he likes and doesn't need much flair when it comes to food! Exactly what Pork Tenderloin Milanese is. A simple easy to make dish with elegant flavors.

First, you're going to cut the pork tenderloin into two-inch medallions. Pound the pork for a tender bite. Make sure the medallions are even on both sides to ensure an even, uniformed cooking.











You will then place your medallions into a batch of seasoned flour. Then dip into beaten eggs and evenly coat with panko breadcrumbs mixed with parmesan cheese.

Pan fry in your choice of Olive Oil or Butter. 2-4 minutes per side or until golden brown. Serve with lemon wedges and topped with a arugula salad! Enjoy!
